




Headlines

- Open age teams/membership increased: 60% increase = female
- Junior membership up by 10% on 2021
- More ethnically diverse: EM membership = Senior 13%; Juniors 18%
- Girls' participation up 55% since '21: Women's participation up 42%
- Saturday League teams steady but static:
- Proportion of female cricketers increasing rapidly




The 2022 Club Audit Focus on Senior Participation Growth

Open-age teams up & overall membership increased (36% since 2013); Just under half of this growth (47%) was female Saturday League teams steady but static Men's senior membership down slightly (3%)











Focus on Junior Growth

Junior participation up a further 10% since 2021, and 69% since 2013 Girls' (Individuals) participation up 287% since 2013 (and up 55% since 2021)




Girls' teams up 26% since 2021 (70% since 2013) Women's teams up 28% since 2021 (87% since 2013)















Female v Male playing proportion 2022




Total Boys & Girls 2021

Women & Men on Club Committees, 2022







Boys & Girls 2013


