Cricket Wales is one of 39 County Cricket Boards that make up the England & Wales Cricket Board (ECB) and is also recognised by Sport Wales and Welsh Government as the National Governing Body for cricket in Wales. Our vision is simple; it is for *'Cricket to Capture the imagination of Wales'* and our goal is to deliver our strategy Inspiring Generations in partnership with our colleagues and friends at Glamorgan Cricket, and our primary funders, the ECB, Sport Wales, Chance to Shine and the Lord's Taverners. We are made up of many different cricket organisations from across the length and breadth of Wales, all sharing a passion for cricket.

Club constitution	An 'open' Club constitution approved by the membership developed from the ECB template
Safeguarding Policy	All members covering a Regulated Activity role hold a valid DBS
Key Officers of the club	Club Chair
	Club Treasurer
	Club Secretary
	Safeguarding Officer (see here) <i>(*Please note the Club Chair and Treasurer must not be the same person. At least three of the people on the committee should be unrelated or not cohabiting.)</i>
Club Bank Account	Registered bank account in the name of the club (<i>with 2 signatories</i>), evidence must be shown on application to League
Play Cricket ID	Registration guidance can be found here ; Whether you're administrating at board level or a player out on the pitch, Play-Cricket is the only free online tool you need to manage the game and access all the latest scores and stats. It's all completely free to use and with just one login you can record, share and track information in a simple, seamless way.
Club insurance	Min Public Liability 5m / Employer's liability 10m. ECB have approved insurers
First Aider:	We recommend every club has a trained first aider within their team who can deal with any medical incidents which occur.
