Expert coaching and strong partnerships

We offer year round coaching provision. Close links with Abergavenny Cricket Club has brought Australian fast bowler, Josh Spies, to coach at CCB for the last two years. Mujahid Ilyas, who works with Cricket Wales will also coach one afternoon per week bringing valuable experience to the programme. We also have strong links with Glamorgan Cricket Club.



Investment in facilities and technology

Recent developments include the installation of six new outdoor artificial nets and the addition of a third wicket on the school fields, ensuring high-quality training for all players.



Expanding horizons through cricket tours

Tours play a key role in enriching the pupil experience. Mixed teams have previously toured in Jersey. This year, we have an exciting international tour to Sri Lanka, where two U15/16 teams, one boy's and one girls', will spend 11 days playing four matches across three regions of the country.
